## Translation Options for Your LEE Clan Zupu – SAMPLE

- 1. Transcription and translation of your straight ancestral line spanning 8 centuries, starting from LEE Bing, your 1<sup>st</sup> ancestor recorded as living in the 12<sup>th</sup> century A.D. in Xinhui, to you, a 27<sup>th</sup> generation descendant of the Yamen LEE Clan. Your straight line will include names in Chinese and Pinyin of all direct ancestors, and if they exist: dates, spouse names, and sibling names.
- 2. Wide family tree of all descendants of your great-grandfather, Lee Kung Yow, down to you. Your tree will include names in Chinese and Pinyin of all family members, spouses' names as listed in the zupu, and dates (if available).
- 3. Transcription of your generation poem, including each character's meaning.
- 4. Translation of the legendary origins of the LEE surname, and your first LEE ancestor in Guangdong province.
- 5. Map of the migration history of the LEE clan, from Northern China to Yamen, spanning 4,000 years.
- 6. Distribution of the LEEs in Guangdong.
- 7. Biographies of your famous LEE ancestors.
- 8. Translation of other famous LEE clan celebrities in Guangdong.
- 9. Description of the ancestral graves of the the Yamen LEE clan, including restoration projects.
- 10. List and description of rituals for ancestral worship in the LEE Ancestral Hall, a temple erected in honour of LEE Bing.
- 11. List of clan rules of the LEE Ancestral Hall (e.g. clan members may not occupy any land owned by the temple; clan members must take turns in participating in temple activities).
- 12. Editor's notes and preface on his reasons for compiling the LEE clan zupu.
- 13. Timeline of refurbishments of the LEE Ancestral Hall, including lists of clan members who made financial donations.
- 14. General background information of the history and culture in Yamen.
